
HOSEA LESSON 25 The City of Adam



Shown above is a large weathered relief on the Bubastite Portal on which the Pharaoh Shishak listed more than 150 cities and peoples that he conquered during his military campaign into Israel and Judah in 925 BC. The city of Adam is identified in the small red box in the lower left corner. See 1 Kings 14:25-26.



The city of Adam is located at the spot of modern-day Damiya on the east side of the Jordan just south of the Jabbok River and 18 miles north of Jericho. The city of Adam was in a strategic location where several trade routes intersected. See Joshua 3:14-16.
